Conversations:

Bonjour.	Hello.

Les Accents:

L'accent aigu: **é** Makes e sound like 'ay'; long 'a' sound, like day

L'accent grave: **è** Makes e sound like 'eh' ; short e sound, like pen. Also seen on à and où with no change in pronunciation.

Le circonflex: **â ê î ô û** No pronunciation change, usually adds an 's' when translated into English (hôpital, forêt)

La cédille: **ç** Makes c sound like s; often used in front of 'a', 'o', 'u'

La tréma: **ë ï ü** Starts a separate syllable(Noël, naïve, Haïti)
